Distance awards for both Ladies and Gents

Recurve and Compound: 90m, 70m, 60m, 50m, 30m.

Teams:

Recurve Team: 3 Archers from 1 club with 1 being a Lady or Junior.
Compound Team: 3 Archers from 1 club with 1 being a Lady or Junior.

Juniors: Individual for both Ladies and Gents

Recurve: 1st, 2nd, 3rd Positions
Compound: 1st, 2nd, 3rd Positions

Junior rounds will be in the following age and gender categories:

Metric 1: Junior Gent under 18
Distances in meters: 70, 60, 50 and 30.

Metric 2: Junior Gent under 16/ Junior Lady under 18
Distance in meters: 60, 50, 40 and 30.

Metric 3: Junior Gent under 14/ Junior Lady under 16
Distances in meters: 50, 40, 30 and 20

Metric 4: Junior Gent under 12/ Junior Lady under 14
Distance in meters: 40, 30, 20 and 10

Metric 5: Junior Lady under 12
Distance in meters: 30, 20, 15 and 10

Awards will be subject to the number of entries per discipline and distance awards will only be awarded to archers who complete the Double WA1440.

Programme: (Both days)

09.15 Assembly at the judge's tent.

09:30 20 mins practice with timing controls and start of competition.

Shooting Order:

The two longest distances, Gents 90/70m, Ladies 70/60m and appropriate Junior Metric distances will be shot in ends of 6 arrows on 122cm faces, within a time period of 4mins. **The two shortest distances Gents and Ladies 50/30m and appropriate Junior Metric distances will be shot in ends of 6 arrows, adult compound and adult recurve archers will shoot on 80cm single spot faces, within a timed period of 4mins. Adult recurve archers may opt to shoot on an 80cm full face by indicating their preference on the entry form. All juniors will shoot on 80cm full faces.**

Equipment:

Equipment inspection will be carried out during the shoot and will be done on a random basis. All arrows must be marked, making them recognisable by the archer and conforming to WA requirements.

Refreshments:

Hot food and drinks will be available between 8.30am - 10.30am and during the lunch break on both days. Drinks and cold snacks will be available throughout the weekend.

Dress regulation 307 will apply.
