| Moving bosses to new distances | Body injury, muscle strain, splinters. Cross Contamination. | All | 2 | 1 | 6 | Working or Cloth gloves are advised to be worn when moving bosses. Gloves help prevent splinter penetration. These gloves, if worn, must be worn over the disposable vinyl gloves; Face Covering (provided by the club) or your own face covering, to be used by archers from different households. Hand sanitiser (provided by the club) to be used prior to and after moving bosses. | 3 |
| Equipment left behind by Archers who have left the Range | Cross contamination from Target Pins and Faces. | All | 2 | 1 | 6 | Any and All Target Faces, Pins and associated Boss equipment left by Archers will be removed and discarded to waste. | 3 |
