Barebow Team: 3 Archers from one club.

Juniors: Individual for both Women and Men

Recurve: 1st, 2nd, 3rd Positions Compound: 1st, 2nd, 3rd Positions Barebow: 1st, 2nd, 3rd Positions

Junior and 50+ rounds will be in the following age and gender categories:

Metric 1: Men under 18 & men 50+ Distances in meters: 70, 60, 50 and 30.

Metric 2: Men under 16/ woman under 18 & 50+ women

Distance in meters: 60, 50, 40 and 30.

Metric 3: Under 15 men and women and under 16 women

Distances in meters: 50, 40, 30 and 20

Metric 4: Under 14 men and women Distance in meters: 40, 30, 20 and 10

Metric 5 Under 12 men and women Distance in meters: 30, 20, 15 and 10

Awards will be subject to the number of entries per discipline and distance awards will only be awarded to archers who complete the Double WA1440.

Programme: (Both days)

09.15 Assembly at the judge's tent.

09:30 20 mins practice with timing controls and start of competition.

Shooting Order:

The two longest distances, Men 90/70m, Women 70/60m and appropriate Junior Metric distances will be shot in ends of 6 arrows on 122cm faces, within a time period of 4mins. The two shortest distances Men's and Women's 50/30m, and appropriate Junior Metric distances, will be shot in ends of 6 arrows. Adult compound and adult recurve archers will shoot on 80cm single spot faces, within a time period of 4mins. Adult recurve archers may opt to shoot on an 80cm full face by indicating their preference on the entry form. All junior, Longbow and Barebow archers will shoot on 80cm full faces.

Equipment:

Equipment inspection will be carried out before the shoot. All arrows must be marked, making them recognisable by the archer and conforming to WA requirements.

Refreshments:

Hot food and drinks will be available from the caterers on both days.

Dress regulation 307 will apply.
